**INGLIS FOUNDATION NAMES SANKEY V. WILLIAMS, MD,  
AS BOARD CHAIR AND ELECTS FIVE NEW DIRECTORS**

**(Philadelphia, PA)** – Inglis Foundation, the non-profit organization that serves people with physical disabilities, has named Sankey V. Williams, MD, as Chairman of the Board of Directors and has elected five new Directors to its Board.

**Sankey V. Williams, MD**, joined the Inglis Board in 2007. He is Sol Katz Professor of General Internal Medicine and former Chief of the Division of General Internal Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He holds a secondary appointment as Professor of Healthcare Management in the Wharton Business School. He and his wife, former Pennsylvania State Senator Connie Williams, reside in Haverford, PA.
